The Oregon Department of Transportation invites eastern Oregon high school students to learn about the construction and utilities trades.

FOUR AREAS OF PARTICIPATION

- **Booth Exhibits** provide valuable information for the students and educators. Contractors, utilities, state agencies, two- and four-year colleges, and trade apprenticeship programs will be among the booth exhibitors.
- **Hands-On Activities** are opportunities for students to perform job-related skills and functions in a controlled environment, such as climbing power poles, using surveying equipment, hydraulic jack hammering, underground utilities inspection, etc.
- **Heavy Equipment** will include static equipment with operators available to explain the nature of their job and related industries. Students will also be given the opportunity to operate some heavy equipment in a controlled, safe environment under skilled direction.
- **Utilities** area will cover a variety of equipment necessary to perform daily maintenance, new construction, or emergency response that most utility companies experience. Students will climb utility poles, experience utility truck bucket use, and learn the day-to-day operation of a utility company's equipment.
