Make sure your experience matches what your program is looking for. See the column below left for assistance.



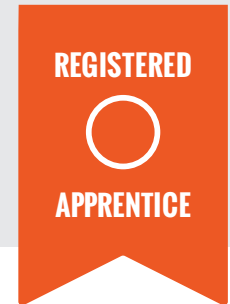
## 3 APPLY
